



Carrier Liability-Claims Settlement

The following example illustrates your claim settlement, depending upon which of the two options you have selected.

CIRCUMSTANCES

Your colour television set is dropped. You bought it four years ago for \$500.00. To buy its equivalent today costs \$650.00. It weighs 30 pounds.

RELEASED RATE SETTLEMENT

At \$.60 per pound, per article the Carrier pays the cost of repairing or replacing the set to a maximum of \$18.00 (i.e. 30 lbs. @ \$0.60 per lb.)

REPLACEMENT COST PROTECTION

The Carrier pays the cost of repair or, if repair is not possible, pays \$650.00 for the equivalent set.

The above is for the purpose of illustrating claims settlement on the basis of Released Rate Liability and Replacement Cost Protection.

North American Van Lines is concerned that you, our customer, are properly protected to a maximum of the actual cost of replacing all of your furniture and personal belongings.
